

Debug

This Action element logs the value of one or more element or session variables. They may either be logged to the console, to a specified file, or to both. If the element is configured to log to a file, and the file cannot be created, then an exception will be thrown.

Settings

Notes:

- If `log_to` is set to `console` or `both`, the console portion of the output will go to application server's console. If the application server is running as a background process (such as a service on Windows), this output may go to a log. Please refer to your application server's documentation for information about where console output is stored.
